

# Education in the United States

USA is one of the most developed countries. Education among Americans is the most important part of life. In the United States also has developed its own system of education, which is largely similar to ours, but still has several significant differences.

In the U.S. there are several levels of education: preschool, primary, secondary, high, higher. That's the only school there last twelve years. People leave school at 18 or 19, but the majority of them only achieved in 21 years.

In the US, education is mainly a state and is under the control of the authorities. 85% of children enrolled in public school. There are also religious and private, of course they are in the minority and give to the child can afford not every family. In American schools, in contrast, there are no strict standards curriculum.

The school budget is formed from taxes on real estate, is local. Therefore, in areas of richer and better schools than the poor. Parents can choose home schooling.

## Elementary school

Primary education the child receives in the older group of the kindergarten. In America children go to school from five years, in the so-called zero class and in some States it visited at will.

Primary school continues until the fifth or sixth grade, that is, up to 11-12 years. As in our country students go through four years of undergraduate. Universities have to be accredited. Universities are both private and state, that is regular. For students from other States the fee twice. The best institutions are Harvard, Stanford, Princeton, Yale and others. Standards of learning and receiving everyone has their own.
